## Logging into the Australian Unique Device Identification Database

For sponsors and manufacturers of medical devices

#### **AusUDID**

The AusUDID stores your **UDI-DIs and related data** for the medical devices in vitro diagnostic devices you supply in Australia. Your UDI records in the AusUDID link to your related inclusion(s) in the Australian Register of Therapeutic Goods (ARTG).

Your TGA Business Services (TBS) account allows you to access 2 AusUDID environments:

- AusUDID Production, the live version of the database
- AusUDID Pre-Production, a training version of the database you can use to test your submission of UDI records.

#### **AusUDID** prerequisites

To access the AusUDID for data submission purposes, you must have a **TBS user account**. If you do not have a user account, contact your organisation's **Administrator**. If your organisation does not have any users or an Administrator, contact the **TBS Helpdesk** at <a href="mailto:ebs@health.gov.au">ebs@health.gov.au</a>.

Select 'Login to AusUDID' on the TBS homepage highlighted in *Figure 1*.

To access AusUDID Pre-Production, please visit https://ausudid-pp.azurefd.net/login.

Select 'Login with TGA' highlighted in Figure 3.

### **Using the AusUDID**




Figure 4: UDI Management Centre

After logging-in you will see the **Home | UDI Management Centre** (*Figure 4*).

From here, you will be able to see published and draft UDI records created by you or others in your organisation.

You can manage any draft or published UDI records created for your organisation, including publishing drafts, adding supporting documents such as Patient Information Leaflets and linking to your ARTG inclusion(s).

#### Testing your UDI data and data submission

If this is the first time someone from your organisation has accessed the AusUDID, your **My UDI records** page will empty.

You can add live UDI records in the Production environment. If you would like to test your UDI before it is 'live', you can add UDI records in the Pre-Production environment.
