1 Name

4 Definitions

Note:

A number of expressions used in this instrument are defined in subsection 3(1) of the Act, including the following:

(a) Secretary.

In this instrument:

Act means the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989.

MD Regulations means Therapeutic Goods (Medical Devices) Regulations 2002.

TGA Business Services means the TGA Business Services portal, accessed via the Therapeutic Goods Administration website.

TG Regulations means Therapeutic Goods Regulations 1990.

Therapeutic Goods Administration, or *TGA*, means the part of the Department known as the Therapeutic Goods Administration.
