Reference: Draft "Code of Good Wholesaling Practice for Medicines in Schedules 2,3,4 and 8"

Dear Sir,

We have reviewed the draft code and advise that the NCCTG could consider strengthening the code in relation to Section 8 – Cold Chain Medicines

Inward goods temperature validation procedures could be improved by wholesalers using infrared detectors or similar commercially available readers, this could add some security to ensuring cold chain has been maintained up to arrival in wholesalers premises.

Shipping of cold chain products containing temperature monitors, recording temperature over time, should enable recipients to properly receipt with satisfaction of cold chain integrity.

Section 8, paragraphs 8.11, 8.12, 8.14 and 8.20 could be strengthened.

The code might also introduce the benefits of improving product batch tracking to aid the ability to recall defective goods
