CONSULTATION: Products used for and by people with disabilities
Options for amendment to the Therapeutic Goods (Excluded Goods) Determination 2018

The Genetic and Rare Disease Network (GaRDN) represents over a hundred support organisations for genetic and rare diseases, who in turn represent thousands of Western Australians.

GaRDN in principle supports

- Option 1(b) that rather than excluding all assistive technologies, the exclusion should be limited to only low risk assistance technologies
- That the real or perceived risks of harm associated with the use of all specified therapeutic goods coming within the definition of low risk assistive technology are relatively insignificant.
