COMPLAINTS RESOLUTION PANEL DETERMINATION

Complaint 4-0802 (Swisse Multivitamins)

The complaint

- 1. A complaint was made about an advertisement for Swisse Multivitamins that appeared in the Sunday Telgraph on 28 July 2002, that the advertisement contained no approval number.
- 2. The sponsor, Swisse Natural Health Care Pty Ltd, said that the advertisement had been approved (CHC 3116-01/07) and accepted responsibility for the advertisement appearing with the number omitted. An assurance was given that, by updating the Swisse ISO Benchmark Advertising Procedures and employment of a team member designated to sign off on all Swisse advertisements before they go to print, the approval of all Swisse advertisements will be ensured.

Panel consideration

- 3. Under Section 42C(5) of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989, a person must not publish or insert in mainstream media an approved advertisement without its approval number.
- 4. The Panel finds the complaint justified.

Sanctions

- 7. In accordance with subregulation 42ZCAI(1) of the Therapeutic Goods Regulations, the Panel requests Swisse Natural Health Care Pty Ltd:
 - (a) to withdraw the advertisement which appeared without its approval number, and which differs from the approved advertisement from further publication; and
 - (b) within 14 days of being notified of this request, to provide evidence to the Panel of its compliance, such as copies of instructions to advertising agents or publishers.
- 8. Attention is drawn to the provisions of subregulations 42ZCAI(3) and (4) which permit the Panel to make recommendations to the Secretary in the event of non-compliance with this request.
