Sodium Fluoride as an active

Please find attached a review on the use of sodium fluoride as an active in pharmaceutical products. On the basis of this review, I recommend that sodium fluoride be allowed for use as an active in Listed medicines on the basis that:

- the preparation includes at least one other therapeutically active Listable ingredient;
- the concentration of the fluoride ion is not more than 1000mg/kg (1000ppm);
- the substance is for use only in pastes, powders or gels for the cleaning of teeth;
- claims in relation to fluoride content are restricted to those relating to improvements in oral hygiene or use of fluoride for the prevention of tooth decay.
