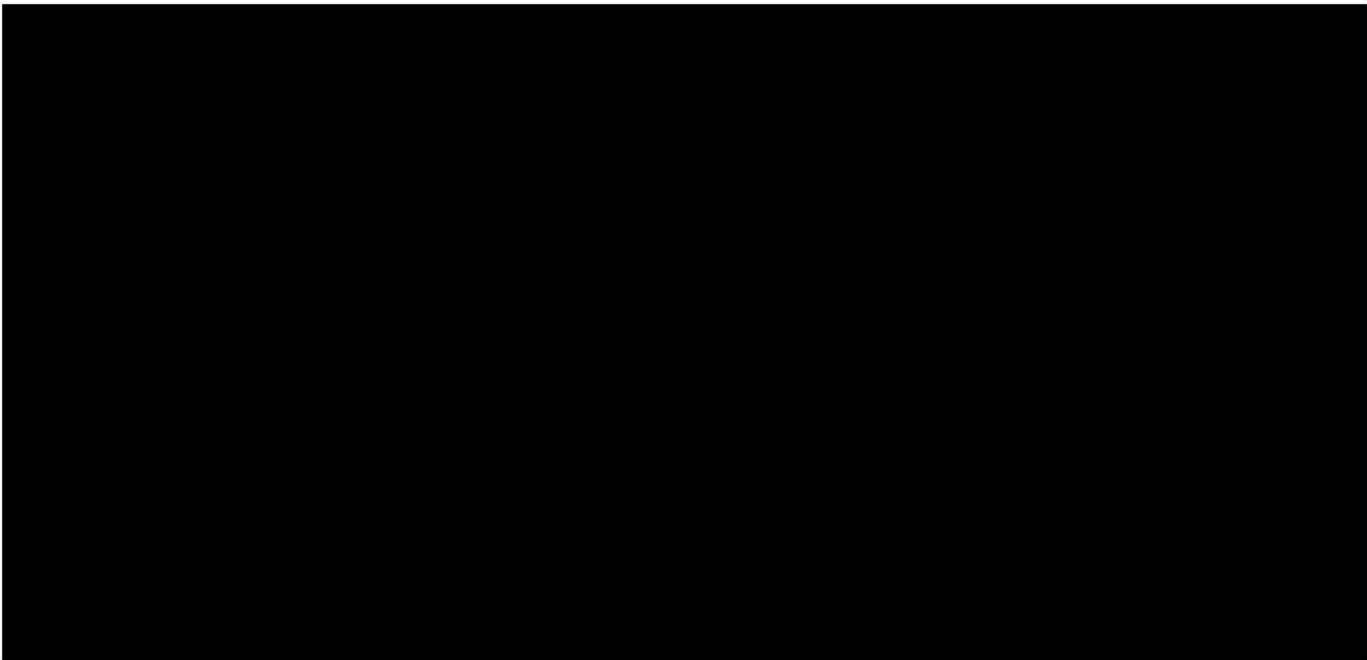

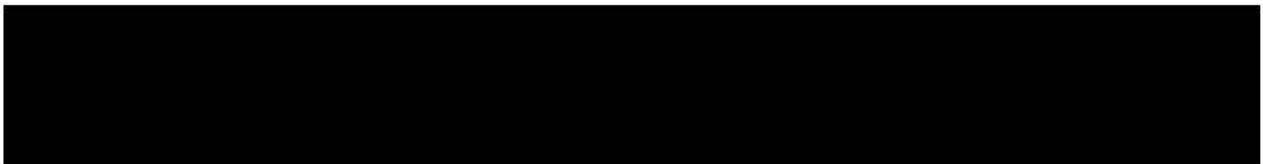

155 of the vaccine reports described reactions to HPV vaccine [REDACTED]. Gardasil was administered in all cases except one [REDACTED].

The majority of the HPV vaccine reports were for girls aged 12 to 17 but 30 described women aged 18 to 25 years, one described a 27 year old female and one described a 77 year old female.
