Therapeutic Goods Act 1989

## Therapeutic Goods (Excluded Goods) Order No. 1 of 1991:

#### TG1/1991

I, STUART HAMILTON, Secretary to the Department of Community Services and Health, make the following Order under subsection 7 (1) of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989* and section 4 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*.

#### Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Therapeutic Goods (Excluded Goods) Order No. 1 of 1991.

#### Commencement

2. This Order commences on the day on which the *Therapeutic Goods Act* 1989 commences.

#### Goods that are not therapeutic goods

- 3. The goods specified in Column 2 of an item in the following Table are, for the purposes of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989* and when they are intended for use in or on humans, declared:
  - (a) when used or labelled in the way specified in Column 3 of that item—not to be therapeutic goods; or
  - (b) if nothing is specified in Column 3 of that item—not to be therapeutic goods.
