THERAPEUTIC GOODS ACT 1989 - SECTION 7 [REDACTED] ORDERS

section 7 order - TG1/1991

Subsection 7(1) of the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989 ("the Act") empowers the Secretary, in the circumstances set out under that provision, to declare particular goods or classes of goods not to be therapeutic goods either in their own right or else when used or labelled in a particular way. I attach for your information a copy of a current s.7 Order (TG1/1991 - "the s.7 Order") prepared by your Office and gazetted on 15 February 1991.

2. The current s.7 Order now requires amendment, or alternatively another s.7 Order could be made, to reflect the following policies:
