(noted that final trials would not be available until after D.H.C. meeting of August 1968). Suggested that, subject to approval of P.H.A.C. & Council, the proposed amendment be forwarded to States and Cafta. (copy of p. 15 of F.S.C. Report 12-13 March 1968).

4. Considered by P.H.A.C. 27-28 May 1968.

and noted that the D.H.C. is to consider this at its next meeting (and agreed that Dr. G.C. Scarr be co-opted to assist (copy of p 23 P.H.A.C. report 27-28 May 1968.

5. Considered by F.S.C. July 1968.

The suggestion by P.H.A.C. regarding amendment.

Agreed to foward an amended Standard to State Food Advisory Committees for Committee listing min. and max. figures for specified food stuffs. (copy of Appendix viii of F.S.C. Report 2-3 July 1968).

## NOTE:

1. Reasons for P.H.A.C. request for minimum and maximum figures:

(1) felt fraud could occur as food could be labelled as containing CaSPhosphate but in amounts too low for therapeutic use and (2) as tests were carried out in the "laid-down range" therefore approval should be for this range. (3) Range allows figures to be policed.

2. Analytical method for CagPhosphate laid down in original application by C.S.R. but not yet considered by F. Analytess June 1969.

- 3. Proposed amended standard has been circulated to States this week but no communication yet received of cause.
- 4. This standard plus comments due to be discussed at next F.S.C. in Sept 1968.
- 5. The final standard due to be discussed at next Food Additives Committees next meeting Feb. 1969.

New Dental Health Committee considerations August 1968.

1. If D.H.C. agrees ok and Food Additives Committee agree might be asked how standard could be presented to F.S.C. at separate meetings and to Council in October 1968.

Action: Could suggest presenting this standard to PH.A.C. as special item in Oct. 1968.

- 2. As we have prepared an amendment to Food Standard may need separate consequential amendments to the specific food standards eg: honey: this could take another 2 sessions of Council plus delay in State legislation.
