The advertisement originates from and is hosted on a US server, and while US websites and social media on are range of subject are often able to be viewed in Australia they have always been outside the jurisdiction of Australian regulatory authorities.

On the topic of the CMN. I wish to correct your incorrect assertion that the TGA threatened the CMN with deregistration of doctors. We have no powers relating to the registration of doctors – this is the domain of peer decisions of the Medical Board of Australia.

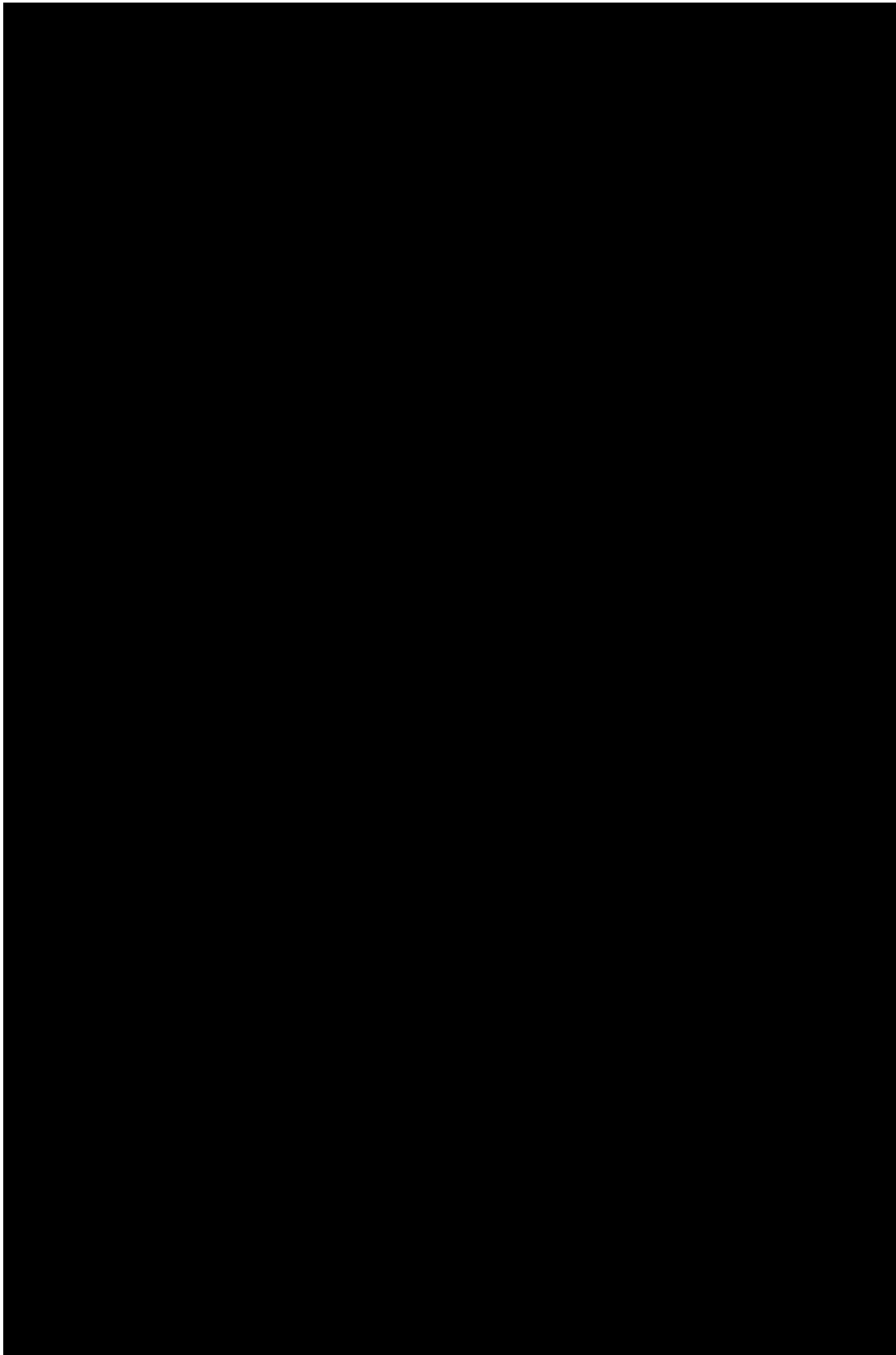

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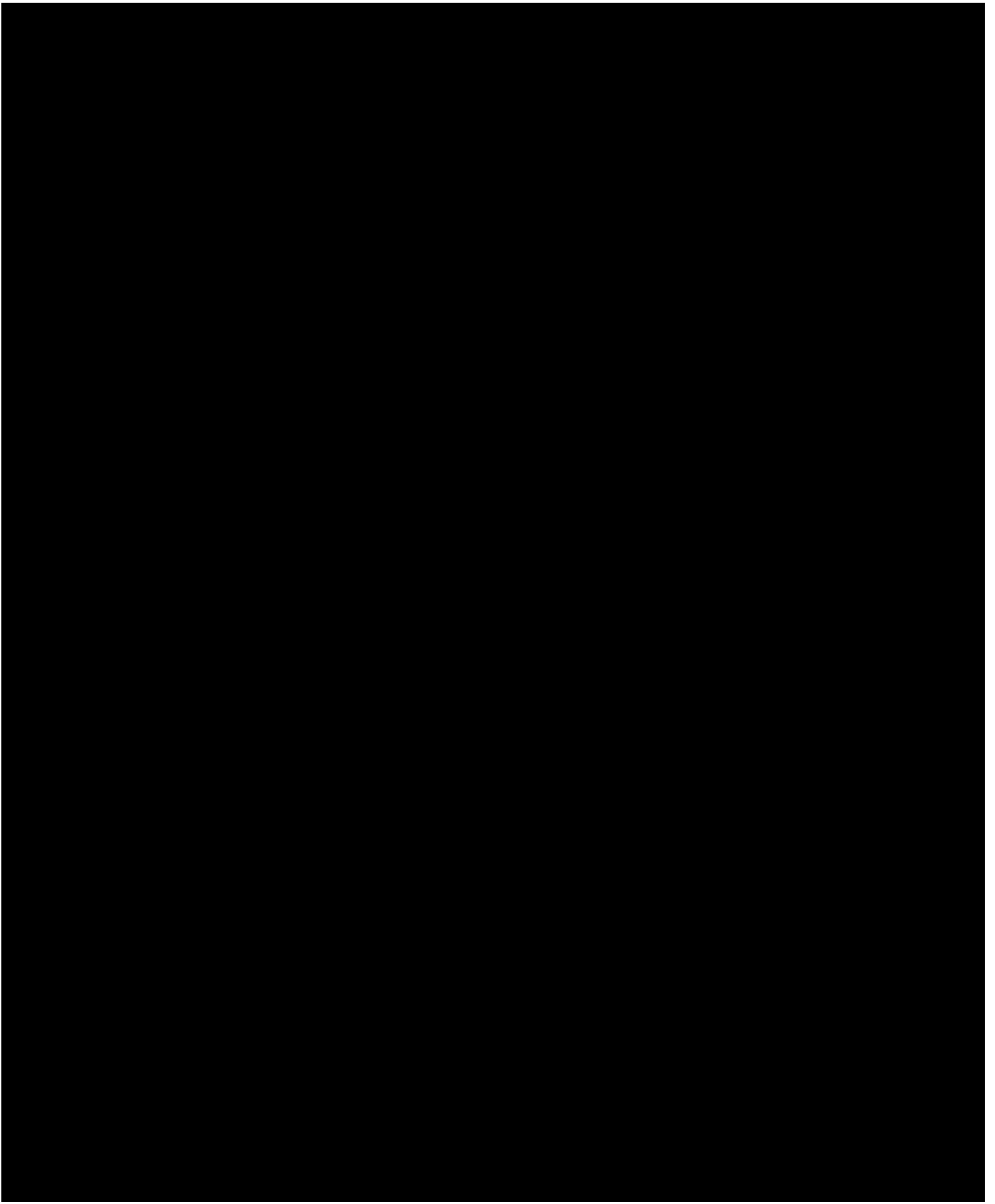
