The poison standard changes remain in force, and they specify that GPs are able to prescribe ivermectin only for registered indications. This does not enable prescription by GPs for treatment or prophylaxis of COVID-19 infection.

The process is that the changes to ivermectin in the poisons standard are compiled with the rest of the poisons standard by the Office of Parliamentary Counsel in the days after the instrument is made and a new compilation is published. This renders the need for a separate instrument redundant on the Federal Register of Legislation.
