Subject: Cannabidiol - proposed amendments to the Poisons Standard [SEC=No Protective Marking]

I note from your web site that submissions closed on 18 May 2020. However it also states "will remain open for public comment until close of business 22 May 2020".

I am generally in support of the proposal in relation to Cannabidiol. However, I note that the Applicant suggests limiting sales of CBD able to be sold in a month's supply. I cannot see the point of this if all other criteria are met. Cannabis has only ever been designated a "poison" or a "drug" by virtue of its THC content. Deriving (extracting) CBD from non-drug cannabis (hemp) should not be limited at all.
