To whom it may concern,

Please note that I would like to make the following submission to have the poison standard amended to include nicotine in tobacco “prepared and packed for heating”. I'm making this submission because it's absurd to have cigarettes legal, when we've known for years how deadly they are, but are even thinking twice about legalising something that is likely to be a far less dangerous alternative.

The tobacco industry has long held power in these decisions, as clearly their money is paying for smokes to remain legal. End the corruption, Queensland needs to move forward.
