It is a right of people in a free world to choose the healthcare they want to use and I uphold my right to treat myself with complimentary health approaches including homeopathy.

I would like to be very clear that all these alternative homeopathic remedies need to remain at their current level of classification whereby they are available to the every day individuals. They would not seek them unless they studied them or have been advised by a person who is qualified.
