Submission to the TGA: options for the future regulation of low risk products

Of the four options under consideration by the TGA, I strongly agree with upholding the following proposed actions:

- 1. Leave homeopathy as it currently is; and
- 2. Require higher scientific evidence for high therapeutic claims

I strongly disagree with the following proposed regulatory actions:

- 3. Exempt certain homeopathics from having to be listed providing the traditional use of homeopathic remedies continues to be acknowledged and preserved
- 4. Declare homeopathic products not to be therapeutic goods.
