To whom it may concern

I write to you in response to your request for feedback on the potential regulatory options for low risk products, and specifically how they may be applied to Homeopathic products.

Fundamental to the AMA Code of Ethics is respecting the patient's right to make their own decisions regarding their health. This includes the right to accept, or reject, treatments and procedures. I firmly believe that removing the recognition of homeopathy from as a therapeutic option under the TGA administered regulations is discriminatory and will deny the patient the ability to choose homeopathy as a complimentary medicine to allopathic medicine.

I propose that Option 1 be adopted, which provides a balance between regulatory requirements and consumer confidence in quality and safety.
