Submission to the Therapeutic Goods Administration in relation to classification of homeopathic medicines

To whom it may concern,

I wish to express my view on the classification of homeopathic medicine:

- I strongly oppose Option 4, which seeks to classify homeopathic medicine as a non-therapeutic good.
- I strongly support Option 1 – the continued classification of homeopathic medicine as a therapeutic good, with no restrictions to access.
- I support option 2.
- I oppose option 3.
