

## **Proposed Amendments to the Poisons Standard (Medicines)**

### **Poppers and Nitrites**

I write regarding the proposal to list poppers ( amyl and other inhalable nitrites ) in the same category as heroin. This is a gross over response for a quite innocuous group of chemicals.

#### **Therapeutic benefit:**

- There is therapeutic benefit being relaxation of specific muscles making gay sex more comfortable and reducing likelihood of tissue damage.

#### **Relative Safety:**

- The chemical group is as a whole, pretty much the least damaging of recreational chemicals.
- There were for a short time, a small number of reports of problems when combined with [REDACTED]. The easy solution is proper labelling and medical advice when prescribing [REDACTED].

- Clean, fresh, properly stored Amyl Nitrite or Butyl Nitrite is available to adults and is properly labelled with appropriate warnings
- IsoPropyl Nitrite is not sold
