### 1 Name

This instrument is the *Therapeutic Goods (Complementary Medicines—Section 26AE Listing) Approval of Application Form and Specification of Office to which Application Must be Delivered.* 

### 2 Definitions

In this instrument:

Act means the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989.

complementary medicine means a medicine of the kind specified in paragraph 4(1)(b) of the Therapeutic Goods (Classes of Therapeutic Goods) Instrument 2018.

*TGA* means the part of the Department of Health known as the Therapeutic Goods Administration.

# 3 Applications to which this instrument applies

This instrument applies to an application to list a complementary medicine under section 26AE of the Act.

# 4 Approved form

For the purposes of subparagraph 23B(2)(a)(i) of the Act, the form titled *Application form to list or vary the listing of an assessed listed medicine*, published by the TGA in March 2018, is approved for an application to which this instrument applies.
