## Widespread therapeutic use of poppers

- Use as a sexual aid by gay and bisexual men and sex workers to make anal sex less painful.
- 45% of gay men in Sydney and 42% of gay men in Melbourne had used poppers in the last six months (GCPS 2018), with similar patterns of use in the other capitals.
- Widespread use, yet extremely low incidence of harm when used for the substance's therapeutic use as an inhalant.
- Anal sex among gay and bisexual men is extremely common and banning a substance that is used regularly as a therapeutic tool during sex between men will be perceived as targeted towards our communities.











## The impact of a schedule 9 listing

- Criminalise the safe therapeutic use of poppers by a significant number of Australians
- Signal to the LGBTIQ community that their sexual practices are deviant
- Increase the availability of unregulated formulations with unknown harms
- Provide enforcement agencies with the power to arbitrarily target gay and bisexual men and sex workers
- Reduce the willingness of community members to discuss poppers with healthcare workers
- Increase the administrative demands on law enforcement agencies
- Will not address the harms associated with unintended misuse (i.e. swallowing)
